They had a blast shopping for supplies, making the cookies, and preparing enough hot cocoa for the craft fair together, and they are ready to set up their concession table! Nick and Penny's parents help them carry in the cookies, hot cocoa, and cups for the event.

Within the first few hours, Bev, Daniel, Nick, and Penny's cookies and hot cocoa sold out! They were so happy that everyone at the event loved what they made and that their hard work paid off. After the event, they wanted to see how much money they made.

$$100 \text{ cookies} \times \$2 \text{ (each cookie)} = \boxed{}$$

$$100 \text{ cups of hot cocoa} \times \$2 \text{ (each hot cocoa)} = \boxed{}$$

Add together how much they made for the cookies and the hot cocoa!

$$\$200 \text{ (cookie profit)} + \$200 \text{ (hot cocoa profit)} = \boxed{}$$

How much do Bev, Daniel, Penny, and Nick each get?

$$\$400 \div 4 \text{ (each)} = \boxed{}$$

Bev, Daniel, Nick, and Penny enjoyed the rest of the craft fair together and were excited they got this great opportunity! They made sure to stop by their local Gateway Metro Federal Credit Union to put their \$100 they earned into their savings accounts!
